The 44th President of the United States stood before millions of people on the day of his inauguration and proclaimed:

This is the price and the promise of citizenship.”

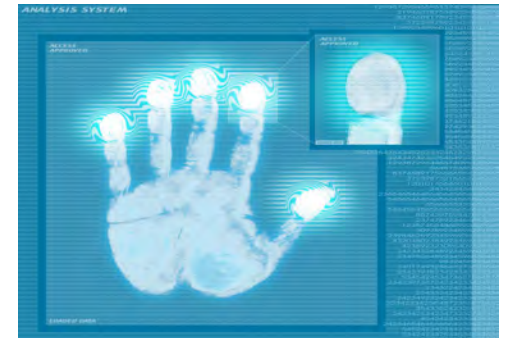
