Undergraduate and Graduate Science Program

- Awards competitive undergraduate scholarships to minors/majors in MESC
- Provides graduate assistantships for NOAA-related research

Student Eligibility and Requirements

- Entering freshmen, other undergraduates and advanced degree candidates who seek careers in NOAA-related research
- Candidates must have and maintain a GPA ≥ 3.0
- Graduate—20 hours/week during academic year
- Undergraduate—must pursue a minor or major in Marine and Environmental Science

Academic Program

- Undergraduate—as required for the MESC degree
- Graduate—Biological Sciences, Environmental Science track

Financial Support

- **Undergraduate**
 - Fall and spring semesters scholarships—\$2000 to \$2500 per semester
 - Summer internship support—Variable
- **Graduate**
 - Full tuition, fees, insurance and stipend -- \$18,000 per year
