General Description: The **A PLUS (A+) SUMMER RESIDENTIAL PROGRAM** is designed for 12 - 16 year-old students who want an adventurous and exciting summer experience. This year's theme is Aviation in the 21st Century: Are You Ready to Soar?

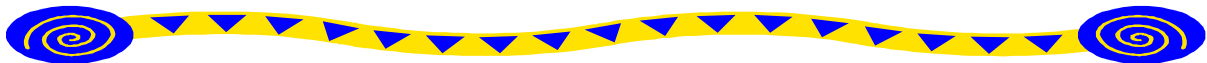
Academics and Activities - The participants will examine the origins of aviation flight from the Wright Brothers to Astronaut Leland D. Melvin, a Virginia native. The student will gain hands on experience by exploring various jobs in aircraft maintenance such as electronics, sheet metal, and engine repair. The history of the Tuskegee Airmen will be discussed with Original Airmen from the Tidewater Chapter. The student will participate in activities such as aerobics, beginning equestrian, board games, bowling, quiz bowl and water sports.

Preparation and Performance - Preparing young people for leadership positions and the responsibilities associated with being a leader is a key element of the **A+** residential program. The students will utilize their newfound skills through various team building activities to establish a foundation for future success in the classroom and life.
