SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE

The MCMD Chapter of the National Hampton Alumni Association announces its Scholarship Award Program for school year 2009-2010.

The Chapter will award two scholarships of up to \$1,500.00 each. The scholarship will be issued in two disbursements, one half per semester, if the recipient continues to be eligible.

The applicant must:

- Be a Montgomery County or Prince Georges County resident,
- Be a Hampton University undergraduate sophomore, junior or senior for the scholarship year,
- Be a full time student for both Fall and Spring semesters, and
- Have a minimum overall GPA of 3.0.

The following items must be received by the Chapter Scholarship Committee by the application deadline of June 15, 2009.

1. Resume (including curriculum of study, organizations, community service, extracurricular activities, awards and employment, if any)
2. One page essay on the topic: "What is the significance to you of the election of Senator Barack H. Obama to the presidency of the United States?"
3. Two letters of recommendation (one character reference from a non-faculty person and one reference from a Hampton University faculty member)
4. Official transcript—request that the University Registrar mail a copy of your official transcript to the Chairman of the Scholarship Committee.

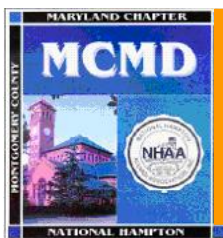
