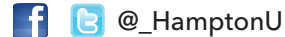

Students who are eligible for admission and who submitted a complete application packet by November 1st will be able to pickup their decision packet during Open House registration. **APPLY NOW!!!**

### Please Note: (Applicant Information)

Prospective students who did not apply by November 1st may BRING a completed application, official high school transcripts, a copy of their social security card, the essay, SAT or ACT scores, three letters of recommendation, and the \$35 application fee. This information can be dropped off during registration. Students who submit information at Fall Open House will receive an admission decision by the fourth week of December.

The Embassy Suites Hampton Roads-Hotel, Spa and Convention Center are closely accessible to the University and have availability November 18-20, 2011 for hotel reservations.
