Tour Guidelines

1. To be eligible for a tour, a participant must have a GPA of 2.0 or better as indicated on a completed school recommendation form. All school recommendation forms are due in the ETS office no later than the deadline for the tour.
2. Students who have been a discipline problem for any staff person jeopardize their chances of being considered for future field trips.
3. It is the responsibility of all tour participants to know the agenda for the tour and to stay with the tour group. Any student who deliberately leaves the group to be off on their own will automatically be ineligible for future trips. **NO student should be alone at any time.**
4. Priority for trip participation will be given to those students who have participated in one or more non-trip activities such as tutoring sessions, workshops and seminars. In addition to attending the tutoring sessions that are scheduled on Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Saturdays, students must attend at least two of the four major activities (Career Day, Cultural Day, Parent/Student Orientation, TRIO Day) to be eligible for the Spring Break Tour.
5. Students who are accepted as participants for a tour are responsible for notifying the Talent Search office immediately if they are unable to attend. Failure to do so may disqualify a student from attending future tours.
6. Students must stay in-groups of at least two persons while on tour. **NO student should be alone at any time.**
