





Are you 18 years or older and registered to vote in state of Virginia?  $100\ \%$  - Yes


#### **Question 4**

To begin with, do you think things in Virginia are generally going in the right direction or are they off on the wrong track?





And how about the region of Virginia that you live in? Do you think things in your region are generally going in the right direction or are they off on the wrong track






Overall, do you approve or do you disapprove of the job Barack Obama is doing as the President of the United States?




#### **Question 13**

Do you generally approve or disapprove of the job Barack Obama is doing in handling the issue of immigration?




Do you generally approve or disapprove of the job Barack Obama is doing in handling foreign policy?





Overall, do you approve or disapprove of the job Terry McAuliffe is doing as Governor?




#### **Question 16A**




#### **Question 16B**




And how certain are you that you will vote for the candidate. Are you very certain, somewhat certain or not certain at all?



Which of the following categories best describes your age?)




What is the last grade in school you completed?



What is your current marital status - are you married, single, living together or engaged, widowed, or divorced?







Do you consider yourself a Democrat, a Republican, or an Independent?


